

**SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 14-05**

**Procedures For Stand-In Attorneys Representing Parents In Family Treatment Court –
Supersedes Administrative Order No. 11-15**

WHEREAS, the Court is modifying the schedule and conduct of the Family Treatment Court (FTC) hearings to improve outcomes for FTC participants, improve the administration of justice, and promote efficient use of Court resources; and

WHEREAS, as part of that modification, the Court will engage Stand-In Attorneys, when necessary, to represent participants in FTC case staffing meetings and FTC review hearings consistent with the attached procedures;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is by this Court,

ORDERED, that the attorneys whose names are set forth in the attachment are eligible to serve as Stand-In Attorneys consistent with the relevant procedures; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Administrative Order shall take effect on March 5, 2014.
